

- North Kawartha Environmental Initiatives Grant
 - 50% up to \$10K
 - To Do:
 - Design simple sign (base on PLiiNK posters)
 - Work with North Kawartha on estimate for creation and installation (Selwyn may also be interest)
 - Consider accessories (eg. Brushes, tongs, chammies)
 - Solicit lake association for 50% funding
 - Apply per process (see attached)
